WW310	<b>Wairau River Sauvignon Blanc 2009</b> This Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc has the classic expressive aromas of gooseberry and tropical fruits. Refined and elegant with a generous mid palate finishing with significant length.	12	75cl
WW311	<b>Wairau River Riesling 2008</b> The palate has an initial explosion of stone – fruit and citrus flavours followed by a taut structure and balanced by the flinty acidity.	12	750ml
WW312	<b>Wairau River Pinot Gris 2008</b> This richly textured wine has a weighty lushness displaying great weight and length.	12	750ml
WR316	<b>Wairau River Pinot Noir 2009</b> Lifted aromas of black cherry and red berries on the nose are framed with savoury oak nuances. The palate is soft with well defined varietal fruit flavours.	12	750ml
WW317	<b>Five Ways Sauvignon Blanc 2010</b> Very clean and refreshing wine from a gem of an estate with wonderful clean finish.	12	750ml
